There is no right or wrong.

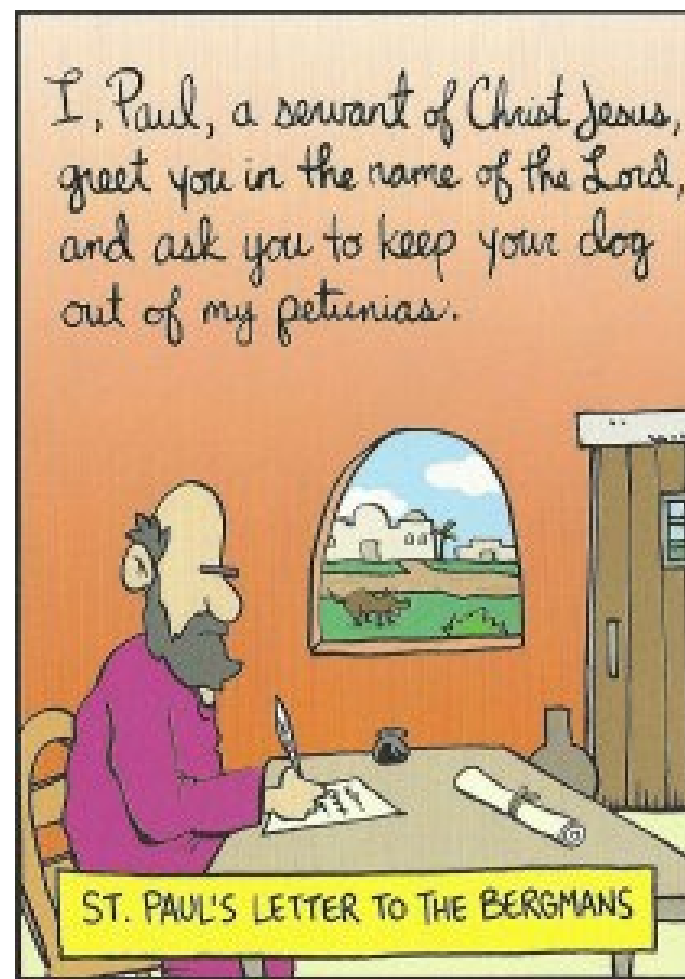
Just tell me of your day
